The candidates provide their peers with a broad overview of global know-how of the sector. They will first compete at a national level, before being confronted for the international final.

# Candidates

The candidates, which are numerous and diversified (both geographically and in terms of types) make a valuable panel for establishing trends in sustainable construction in participating countries.
